## Course Overview

This course provides a familiarisation with the roles and responsibilities of the EOC Planning / Intelligence (P/I) function and provides an opportunity to perform the processes involved within the function. On completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Perform the P/I roles and responsibilities
- Participate in P/I activities
- Coordinate P/I activities internally and externally at the EOC

The following topics are covered:

- Purpose and roles of the P/I function
- Suggested staffing for the P/I function
- Organisational structure for the P/I function
- Relationship between the P/I function and other EOC functions
- Co-ordination and interface of the P/I function with other levels of response
- Lines of authority
- P/I function activities
- Equipment, material and systems recommended to operate the P/I function
- Role the P/I function plays in information management
- Decision making - types of decisions the P/I staff can make and process for doing so
- Documentation, display boards and situation maps appropriate to the P/I function
