Course Overview

This course provides foundation training for both damaged and collapsed structures
The course included both theory and practical modules including:

- NZ USAR History and Structure
- Hazards and Safe Working Practice
- Building Collapse Patterns
- Belaying and Lowering
- 1,2,4 point Stretcher Lower
- Improvised Lowers
- Safe work with ladders
- Ladder Slide and Ladder Hinge

There are a total of three workbooks to complete for this course, with practical assessment included along the way. In most cases the workbooks are also completed during the course, with some work at home required.

Unit Standards Acquired

18516 Demonstrate knowledge of, and provide support at, urban search and rescue operations
20473 Ground Based Rescue
24500 General Rescue at Height (new)
7318 or 10618 old General Rescue (still required for some qualifications)

These unit standards are a significant part of the Industry Certificate in USAR Response (Orange Card). As time allows we will include Coordinated Incident Management System (CIMS) – unit standard 17279.
