- explain the legal authority for establishing a cordon
- cordon an area to restrict public and vehicle access
- establish a perimeter control point to manage the flow of people and vehicles into and out of a cordoned area
- direct and monitor the movement of vehicles through a control point
- remove cordons to allow resumption of normal public access.
