<b>Course Purpose</b>	This course has been designed to provide participants with key knowledge and skills to undertake storm damage operations.
<b>Course Outcomes</b>	On completion of this course, participants will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Prepare for storm response</li><li>▪ Mitigate the effects of storm damage</li><li>▪ Maintain personal and team safety while responding to the storm damage</li><li>▪ Employ a fall arrest system on a storm damaged roof</li><li>▪ Recover and restore storm damage response equipment</li></ul>
